

BHBL Junior Baseball

Return to Play Guidelines

1. All players, coaches and spectators will sign a COVID-19 waiver prior to entering the field area. Waivers will be saved and used for contact tracing, if necessary.
2. Safety Committee members checking temperatures and getting waivers signed must wear a mask.
3. If anyone from your household is awaiting results of a COVID-19 test, please stay home until results are back.
4. If a player or coach is not feeling well stay home.
5. All players, coaches, and umpires will have their temperature checked by a safety committee member. If an individual registers a temperature of 100.4 F, they will be asked to sit in a shaded area for 20 minutes and then return for temperature recheck. If still at or above 100.4 F, the individual will not be allowed to participate. This includes practices.
6. Players and coaches will have temperature checked for practices. Social distancing needs to be in place at practices.
7. All players, coaches, and umpires must wear a mask when getting their temperature checked.
8. 2 spectators per player.
9. Spectators must watch the game from the outfield area. This is the only area spectators will be allowed to watch the game. Spectators must maintain proper social distancing at all times. If you are unable to do this you must have a mask on.
10. Players and coaches must maintain 6ft of social distancing in the dugout area. 1 Coach and 2 players will be allowed in the dugout at a time. The rest of the team will be spread out 6ft apart along the fence. Players please bring your own chair for your seat.
11. NO CONTACT Player to player or player to coach. No high fives, fist bumps, elbow bumps are allowed.
12. No spitting, seeds, or gum is allowed.
13. No shared drinks.
14. No team water coolers.
15. No shared equipment.
16. Hand sanitizer station will be in each dugout and located around the facility.
17. Players must sanitize their hands when going out to play in the field and when they return to the dugout.
18. Only registered coaches are allowed on the field during games and practices.
19. Baseballs will be used for 1 at bat, then need to be sanitized before returning to play. Foul balls are to be retrieved by a player or coach. Spectators are not allowed to touch baseballs.
20. All surfaces in the dugout will be sanitized before and after the games by Coaches or Safety Committee.
21. Bathroom facilities will be disinfected before and after the games by Coaches or Safety Committee.
22. If a second game is being played on the same field in a day, everyone from the first game must leave before allowing players and spectators into the field area.
23. Return to play rules issued by ESBL need to be reviewed by teams playing in ESBL.
24. Return to play rules issued by ENYTB need to be reviewed by teams playing in ENYTB.

All of the guidelines are subject to change, at any time based, on directions from local and state health officials
