



ENYTB and Game Day Guidelines

These guidelines that are put in place by the BHBL organization for play in the spring/summer 2020 season are in addition to ENYTB Health & Safety Guidelines During COVID-19, ESBL Guidelines, as well as, local, state, and national guidelines.

General Guidelines:

1. All players, coaches and spectators will sign a COVID-19 waiver prior to entering the field area. Waivers will be saved and used for contact tracing, if necessary.
2. All players, coaches, and umpires will have their temperature checked by a safety committee member. If an individual registers a temperature of 100.4 F, they will be asked to sit in a shaded area for 20 minutes and then return for temperature recheck. If still at or above 100.4 F, the individual will not be allowed to participate.
3. All players, coaches, and umpires must wear a mask when getting their temperature checked.
4. 2 spectators per player.
5. Spectators must watch the game from the outfield area. This is the only area spectators will be allowed to watch the game. Spectators must maintain proper social distancing at all times. If you are unable to do this you must have a mask on.
6. No spitting, seeds, or gum is allowed.
7. There will be no concessions at the field.
8. Bathrooms will be sanitized and disinfected before and after each game by BHBL staff.

Pregame Guidelines:

1. Teams arriving at the field may report no earlier than 45 minutes before game time.
2. When they arrive, they must check in with the safety committee to have temperatures checked and sign a waiver. Then they can report to their dugout area. If there is a game going on when teams arrive the must wait until the game is completed and everyone has left the playing area before reporting to the field.
3. There is no batting cage used on game day.
4. Dugout areas will be cleaned and ready for the teams when they arrive for the game.
5. Hand sanitizer will be in the dugouts at all times. It will be provided by BHBL.

During Game Guidelines:

1. Each manager shall designate one individual to retrieve supplies during the game as needed.
2. Managers shall designate one individual, preferably an assistant coach, to retrieve foul balls while their team is the defensive team.
3. Managers, coaches, and scorekeepers shall utilize gloves, masks/shields/face coverings as necessary.
4. While on offense, players will wait outside the dugout along the first base and third base sideline, outside the field fence. The batter, subsequent runners, one "on deck" batter, and one "in the hole" batter will be allowed in the dugout. There is no "on deck" batter on the field.
5. Players may also wait in the dugout with appropriate face coverings and/or, maintain acceptable social distance measures.
6. While on defense, players not in the field may sit in the dugout area.
7. All players and coaches must sanitize their hands before going on the field and when leaving the field.

Post-Game Guidelines:

1. All teams will make sure that the dugout area is clean. BHBL Safety Committee and coaches will make sure that the dugout areas are sanitized and disinfected.
2. After completion of games there will be no team meetings on the field. All players and coaches are to clean the area and leave the playing area ASAP.
