

2021 T-BALL Rules

- 1. Games are three innings (two-hour time limit)**
- 2. All players must play the same amount.**
- 3. Teams should use a continuous batting order.**
- 4. An inning consists of all players in the batting order batting once per inning.**
- 5. Base runners move one base at a time.**
- 6. Runners can not advance on overthrows or errors.**
- 7. No bunting, leading or stealing.**
- 9. All batters will use the batting tee the beginning of the year. After Memorial Day coaches may pitch to the kids. The players will get three attempts to hit the ball before the batting tee is used for the rest of the at bat.**
- 10. There are no walks**
- 11. Coach should stand behind the Batter to retrieve passed balls and help instruct batters.**
- 12. All players in the field**
 - a. Infield: first, second, shortstop, third, pitcher (2)**
 - b. Outfield: right-field, left-field, left-center, right-center**
- 13. Helmets must be worn by at first base, third base, and pitchers' position.**
- 14. Players may slide. No head first sliding.**
- 15. There is no on deck position.**
- 16. Four adults (Coaches) allowed on the Field. (must have valid background check completed)**
- 17. There should be a 15-20 minute practice/instruction before each game begins.**
- 18. All Bats must have the USA Baseball T-ball stamp on Bat.**
