

BHBL Junior Baseball 2021 Guidelines

Please remember the goal is for the kids to have a fun, safe season. These guidelines were developed by the BHBL Junior Baseball Committee and approved by the BHBL Junior Baseball Board.

- Social distancing and Masks
 - Coaches will have the choice of spaces to choose what is right for their players. A decision must be uniform within the team.
 - Option A: Your team may utilize the dugout and masks must be worn while in the dugout.
 - Option B: Your team may utilize the marked space outside the dugout. If 6 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained, masks must be worn.
 - No shared drinks, or team water coolers
 - No shared equipment.
 - If a player does not have the needed equipment, equipment can be shared if all equipment is properly sanitized between use by different players.
 - Social distancing must be adhered to during practices
- Temp checks
 - All players, coaches, and umpires will have their temperature checked prior to enter the field by a team representative. If an individual registers a temperature of 100.4 F, they will be asked to sit in a shaded area for 20 minutes and then return for temperature recheck. If still at or above 100.4 F, the individual will not be allowed to participate.
- COVID 19 testing protocols
 - If anyone in your household receives a positive COVID-19 test result, all members of the household will refrain from practice, games and defer to the local DOH.
 - If a team member is awaiting results, the player will refrain from practicing until results are received
 - If a team member receives positive tests results, play will immediately suspend and the team will defer to the local DOH
- Other
 - If a player and/or coach is not feeling well, please stay home.
 - Hand sanitizer station will be in each dugout and located around the facility.
 - All surfaces in the dugout will be sanitized before and after the games by Coaches or Safety Committee.
 - Bathroom facilities will be disinfected before and after the games by Coaches or Safety Committee.
 - If a second game is being played on the same field in a day, everyone from the first game must leave before allowing players and spectators into the field area.
 - Travel BHBL baseball teams will adhere to all rules put forth by opposing team(s) when traveling.
- Return to play rules issued by ESBL need to be reviewed by teams playing in ESBL.
- Return to play rules issued by ENYTB need to be reviewed by teams playing in ENYTB.
- All of the guidelines are subject to change, at any time based, on directions from local and state health officials
